

Deducted costs from sponsorship

Your minimum sponsorship target is £395, which you must have raised by the day of your skydive. The cost of your Parachute for Prospect jump with Go Skydive is £225, £50 of which you paid in your deposit. There are a number of options for how to pay outstanding £175 jump fee:

- **Pay yourself** – all sponsorship raised goes direct to Prospect Hospice and you pay the £175 jump fee yourself.
- **Pay out of your sponsorship** – if you raise all or most of your sponsorship through cash using a paper sponsorship form, you can bring this to the airfield on the day of your skydive and pay £175 to Go Skydive. All sponsorship over £175 must be returned to Prospect Hospice.
- **Pay via invoice** – If you raise all or most of your money through an online donation page, we can arrange for Prospect Hospice to be invoiced by Go Skydive 2 weeks prior to your skydive. All sponsorship money over £175 will be retained by Prospect Hospice.

Our challenge event fundraiser will be in contact with you in the weeks leading up to your skydive to confirm how you would like to pay your jump fee. Please note that the £220 you raise in sponsorship past the £175 jump fee must be returned to Prospect Hospice by the day of your skydive.

All sponsors and donators should be clear that Prospect Hospice will not be receiving all of the money raised from your sponsorship. Therefore terms such as *'all money raised goes to Prospect Hospice'* should not be used and instead terms such as *'all money raised goes towards 'Joe Blogg's' fundraising target for Parachute for Prospect'*.

If you are struggling to fundraise and reach your sponsorship target, please contact the challenge event fundraiser. Below are some fundraising targets that may be useful to ensure you raise the minimum £395 by the day of your skydive:

50% of your minimum sponsorship	Due 10 weeks before the event
75% of your minimum sponsorship	Due 6 weeks before the event
100% of your minimum sponsorship	Due 2 weeks before the event
