In our 2019 booklet, you will find many different ways to get involved and support your local hospice.

Last year it cost £8.4M to run the hospice services which cared for and supported 7.300 patients and family members across our community. Only 28 per cent of the costs were funded by statutory sources, all of the rest came from you, our local community.

Without your support, we cannot continue to reach those patients and families who need our support. We are hugely grateful to each and every person who supports Prospect Hospice in whatever way they can. Your support and the funds you raise enables us to continue to provide our specialist endof-life care free of charge in your local community.

- £60 pays for two hours of Prospect@Home care


TREK TO THE LOST CITY

As the world gets smaller it becomes harder to visit places that are truly still wild, yet this tough trek through dense tropical rainforest gives you the opportunity to do just that, as you trek along the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta mountains along overgrown and muddy trails.

You'll pass indigenous Kogui communities and sleep in hammocks before climbing the 1,200 ancient stone steps that lead up to the ruins of Teyuna, dating back some 1,500 years and known as the Lost City.

Prospect Hospice's gardens have long provided a peaceful haven for patients, families, friends and visitors. We recognise the importance of celebrating life, remembering those people who were special to us and keeping their memories alive.

Our Memory Tree sits in the heart of our Remembrance Garden and features copper and silver leaves, engraved with the names of cherished loved ones. Anyone can create a leaf in memory of a loved one, even if you haven't previously been connected to the hospice through our services.

Our Remembrance Garden is designed to be visited all year round, with lighting in place for evening guests. It has been designed so that you can visit your memorial tribute at a time special to you.

To order, visit our website and select your leaf type, add your special name and preferred donation method, from monthly direct debit, or an annual donation. If you prefer we can send a leaflet to you in the post.

By creating your leaf you will be helping provide the prospect of specialist support to local families affected by a life limiting illness.
